## Delegates to 2021 Convention

Canon 205.1 Calculation of Lay Delegates. Each Congregation in union with Convention is entitled to be represented by lay delegates based on its number of active baptized members stated in the parochial report for the previous year, as follows:

Note: This number comes from your 2019 Parochial Report. If the parochial report is not filed, the clergy in charge of the congregation may not have seat or vote. (Canon 204.2)

**Canon 207.1 Election.** The Lay delegates of a Congregation are elected for a three-year term from and by its qualified voters, at its annual meeting immediately preceding the annual Convention, or by its vestry or bishop's committee thereafter, according to a schedule determined by Council.

**a.** The lay delegates must be elected at least ninety days before the meeting of Convention for which they are elected, or else they may not take seats at Convention without the consent of a majority of Convention, both orders voting together.

Canon 207.2 Term of Office. Lay delegates hold office for three consecutive annual meetings of convention.
